

National Taiwan University College of Public Health Global Health Program
International Student Scholarship Awards

This scholarship aims to award outstanding international students in the Global Health Program and promote learning.

Eligibility:

1. For M.S. and Ph.D. students:
 - a. 3.2 GPA or above from the previous semester
 - b. The scholarship application should be submitted by the deadline announced at the beginning of each semester.
2. Each semester, the Global Health Program reviews the applications and decides the amount to be awarded to each student per student's overall performance and financial needs.
3. In some special circumstances where the student cannot meet the GPA requirement, they can ask for their application be reviewed by the Global Health Program faculty for eligibility.

Prospective students may apply for this scholarship along with their application to the program. Existing students may apply for this scholarship every semester when the application procedures are announced.

The scholarship amount covers either full or partial tuition and fees. The scholarship amount given each year will be adjusted annually based on the current budgetary plan, financial revenue, and the number of international students accepted.

This scholarship is to be used as a tuition waiver/assistance. The funding sources for these scholarships come from the Office of International Affairs, the Ministry of Education, or related funding from the College of Public Health.

Scholarships are only valid for the time specified in the award letter and cannot be deferred, except in special cases decided by the Global Health Program faculty. If a student withdraws from school, suspends their studies, or if the college decides to discontinue the student's grant for academic or disciplinary reasons before graduation, scholarship recipients must return the received scholarship (in the form of tuition waiver) to the Global Health Program.
